Retired workers have always played a vital part in the achievements of the AMWU.

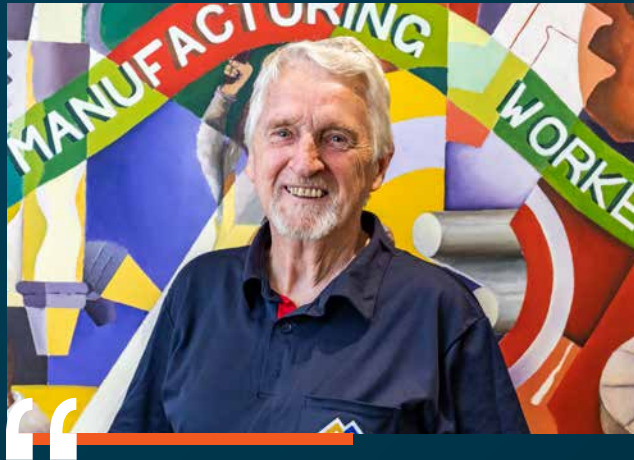
